Trout Unlimited Project Little Truckee River Rehabilitation

Off-highway vehicle (OHV) use has exploded in recent years throughout the Tahoe NF, especially around Stampede, Boca and Prosser Reservoirs. The first angler driven Truckee River Day event will restore a section of the famous Little Truckee River, the primary goal being to restore areas degraded by illegal hill climbs caused by OHV use.

This project involves closing off two roads through mulching, piling branches, building water diversions and water bars, raking pine needles, installing signs, and placing large boulders. This is a project for all ages! Staff and professionals will do all the heavy lifting. Come help!

We will contact you in October with details about your project, including what to bring, when to meet, and where to meet. Typically, projects run from 9 AM to about 2 PM.

Agreement, waiver, and release – must be signed by all volunteers

This waiver and indemnification agreement shall apply regardless of any negligence or carelessness of any person or entity. I give the Truckee River Watershed Council and the United States Forest Service permission to use, for publicity purposes, any photographs or video footage including my likeness, which may be taken during Truckee River Day.
